The Food and Agriculture Organization of the United Nations (FAO) and the Center for International Forestry Research (CIFOR), lead center of the Research Program on Forests, Trees and Agroforestry (FTA) of the CGIAR, are pleased to invite you to a webinar to get feedback on the outline of their forthcoming publication Land use and the Koronivia Joint Work on Agriculture.

Following the adoption of the **Koronivia Joint Work on Agriculture (KJWA)** at the 23rd Conference of the Parties to the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change (UNFCCC), FAO and the Research Program on Forests, Trees and Agroforestry (FTA) of the CGIAR joined forces to develop a publication on land use and the KJWA.

The purpose of this publication is to consider how the KJWA relates to the broader topic of land use, including how agriculture interacts with other land uses. This paper will examine the question of land use in relation to the KJWA, starting from the interrelations between different land uses, their dynamics and their overall potential contributions to climate change action and to sustainable development, taking into account synergies and trade-offs. It will examine how these issues could be taken into account by Parties in their discussions under the KJWA, but also how they relate to the current implementation of the Nationally Determined Contributions, and more generally to achieving the targets of the Paris Agreement.

This webinar will provide an opportunity to present and discuss the outline and different sections of the publication, as well as to gather feedback and comments from participants.
