map of the sub grant project site



Lennertz, May 1994). The relief derived vulnerabilities and altitude between 1,650m to "Plain" and 2,643 m at its highest point, which is the Tsiafajavona, is very rugged and is characterized by very steep slopes and numerous rocky outcrops.
